

Dear Parents and Guardians of BHS Class of 2026,

Congratulations on what is the beginning of an exciting year for both you and your Senior. We hope that you all enjoy every minute of it because the year will pass by before you know it. The purpose of this letter is to inform you of the dates and expenses that your Senior may incur this year. **This year Graduation is scheduled for Wednesday, May 20 at 8:00 PM in the stadium (pending GCPS approval).**

- All graduating Seniors will receive 10 tickets to Graduation which will be given out at Graduation Practice the morning of May 20.
- To receive your Graduation tickets, **all outstanding fees must be paid.**  
This includes, but is not limited to:
  - Media Center fees
  - Chromebook/Calculator fees
  - AP Exam fees (this also includes Spring 2026 AP Exam fees for missed exams)
  - Parking Violations
  - Please check the Fees tab on MyPaymentsPlus throughout the year to make sure these are all taken care of prior to May.

**All Seniors are required to pay Senior Dues.** Senior dues are \$175 and include cap, gown, tassel, Senior Picnic, diploma, diploma cover, and other Graduation expenses. Please note the following:

- Beginning **February 1**, dues will increase to \$200.
- **All dues paid before March 1**, will also include the official BHS Class of 2026 Senior Shirt with the names of all Seniors listed on the back. Any dues paid March 1<sup>st</sup> or later will no longer include the Senior shirt.
- Cap and Gowns will be delivered on April 1 during all lunches.
