

**Waits River Valley School
After School Program**

We are eagerly awaiting the completion of our licensure so that we can begin welcoming scholars for our After School Program. We will know more by next Wednesday, so please be sure to be watching for more information regarding our start date.

We are still accepting applications. The program runs from 3-5 PM Monday-Friday, except for holidays, early release days and Inservice days. The cost is \$10 per scholar per day which is due on the Friday of each week, in advance of the following week, and should be paid to Lisa Thompson in the front office, either by cash or check.

Your scholar can be signed up to use the After School Program Monday through Friday, or you can pick days that you are only in need of, or you can choose to differentiate the days weekly. If you don't use the program on a regularly scheduled week, you must sign them up on the Friday before the following week so that adequate staffing can be available.

If you are income eligible, you can complete the application for subsidy through the Child Care Financial Assistance Program and submit via mail, or you can fill out the online application through the Child Development Division Information System. This information can be found on our [website](#).
