Over the past few years, the administration and staff have demonstrated an overwhelming commitment to offering innovative programs that will prepare students like yourself for life beyond the walls of Roxbury High School. Among the many efforts to enhance the instructional program and prepare students to meet college and career-ready goals, the school has established a variety of collegiate partners who have agreed to offer dual enrollment credit for courses taken at Roxbury High School. While these partnerships provide an exciting jumpstart on your future, they present the need for consideration and planning with your parent(s) and school counselor. You will need to identify if you intend to purchase the credits and which university you desire to purchase the earned credits by the posted deadline by submitting the proper paperwork from the university to your school counselor. You can acquire the necessary paperwork from your school counselor. Please note, that you may remain enrolled in the course at Roxbury High School without purchasing any dual enrollment credits. Below is a listing of all dual enrollment courses, the university that will support credit attainment, and the total cost to purchase the credits at the associated institution. Each dual enrollment partnership is associated with a three (3) credit collegiate course. Please note the three specific partnerships below the table.

College Writing (\$1563.10 for 3 credits) - Rutgers University

* For Expository Writing, credits are purchased at the conclusion of the course.

Tomorrow's Teachers (\$250 for 3 credits) - Kean University

*Registration will occur in mid-September

Drone Technologies (\$0 for 3 credits) - Warren County Community College

*UAS 105 Remote Pilot Operations (Part 107) – Students who take the Part 107 and successfully pass will receive a corresponding grade and 3 credits from WCCC free of charge.

*UAS 210 (AUVSI) – Students who purchase their AUVSI certification will receive 3 credits from WCCC at no additional cost to the student.

As your individual plans become clearer, we would recommend that you reach out to the Registrar's Office at your anticipated college(s) regarding the acceptability/transferability of credits attained through dual enrollment offerings.
