More than 300 students enrolled in band, orchestra, and choir classes at North High School will have the opportunity to learn and grow as leaders as they attend a workshop led by nationally recognized speaker Bobby Lambert.

From 9 a.m. to noon, about 40 selected band, choir, and orchestra students will work with Lambert in a focused intensive session featuring small group work focused on student and servant leadership. From 1 p.m. to 3:50 p.m. all North High School music students will have the opportunity to attend a large-group leadership workshop with Lambert.

Lambert's presentations aim to inspire students to grow and become leaders to be by utilizing skills from the world of business, marketing, and psychology. By building leadership skills, Lambert aims to help school music ensembles produce exceptional musical outcomes while empowering students.

Lambert is the director of bands at Wando High School in South Carolina. He has been teaching band leadership since 1997. He has presented leadership workshops, concert clinics, and staff training, and offered one-on-one mentorship to band students and instructors since 1997.
