2025-MR-1.5 Recognitions and Presentations

Oath of Office for Student Board Member Mazie Fitzharris

“Do you solemnly affirm that you will support the Constitution of the United States of America and the Constitution of the State of Ohio and that you will faithfully and impartially discharge your duties as a member of the Board of Education of the Delaware City School District, Delaware, Ohio, to the best of your abilities and in accordance with the laws now in effect and hereinafter to be enacted during your continuance in said office and until your successor is appointed.”

Hayes High School -

Dr. Shafer presented preliminary data from the Ohio State Tests (OST) and shared a preview of what the upcoming state report card may reflect.

He highlighted several encouraging trends in student performance:

- Consistent growth in overall proficiency across subject areas
- An increasing number of students achieving at the *Advanced* level
- A decrease in the number of students scoring in the *Basic* and *Limited* performance ranges
- A notable reduction in the number of untested students
- He expressed optimism about these positive trends and the potential for continued academic progress.

Dr. Shafer credited this progress to the collective efforts of staff, students, and families. Contributing factors include:

- A dedicated and collaborative teaching staff, aligned in instructional practices
- Ongoing development and implementation of a standards-based curriculum
- Effective intervention programs

2.1. Unions

- A. DCEA - Natalie Geer reported that New Employee Orientation took place today and noted that the union is looking forward to another committed year of collaboration.

2.2. Legislative - Mr. Pomeroy reported on new legislation requiring a revision to the Personal Communication Devices policy, with the first reading of the updated board policy presented in Section 4.1.

2.3. Facilities -

- Mr. Sherman provided updates on several facility and transportation projects:
 - Paving and asphalt project at Hayes.
 - Security access control installation is in progress.
 - The chiller project at Willis has been completed.
 - He presented Agenda Item 5.7 for approval of bus routes.
 - He also discussed the current limitations in available bus drivers while training of new drivers is ongoing.

2.4. Treasurer/CFO - CFO Corwin reported ongoing progress toward the fiscal year closing and preparation for the upcoming audit. She noted that legislative changes continue to be monitored. She also presented the April financial reports for board approval.

2.5. Assistant Superintendent - Dr. Swanger reported that New Teacher Orientation took place today, with 30 new teachers receiving information and support from various departments.

2.6. Executive Director of Human Resources - Ms. Kooi presented the consent agenda for approval.

2.7. Superintendent -

- Mr. Pomeroy reported that the Supplies for Scholars event has served 1,400 students to date. He described it as a fantastic event that benefited both students and families.
- Mr. Pomeroy shared an update from Mr. Drennen regarding Food Service:
 - Additional staff have been hired.
 - Cafeteria staff have been reconfigured across buildings.
 - New equipment is being presented for consideration under Action Item 5.8.
 - Students eligible for reduced-price lunches will receive meals at no cost.
 - The Summer Lunch Program served 1,597 student meals, thanks to partnerships with Andrews House, People In Need, and a team of volunteers.
- Ms. Fry provided an update on multiple safety and technology initiatives, including:
 - Implementation of access control and visitor management systems.
 - A pilot for environmental sensors.
 - Security camera replacements.
 - Ongoing training related to these projects.
 - The Board expressed appreciation to the Technology Department for their outstanding work on these projects.
