IMPORTANT SEPTA UPDATE

New state funding has not yet been approved, so SEPTA has moved forward with new fall schedules that implement 20% service cuts, including the elimination of 32 bus routes and significant reductions in trips on all metro rail services. SEPTA riders are now able to use SEPTA.org and the SEPTA app to view the service cuts schedules in the trip planner and on schedule pages. To view the



schedules, enter a date after the cuts go into effect and ensure that you have downloaded the latest version of the SEPTA app (3.2.6). For more information, please visit <https://www.septa.org/fundingcrisis/service-cuts/> or review the attached *August 2025 SEPTA Service Cuts Rider Guide*. These service cuts do not impact your student's eligibility to receive a SEPTA Student Fare Card, however they will likely impact your student's commute to/from school. **Please make a plan with your student so that they continue to attend school on a daily basis and arrive on time. The school will not excuse late arrivals or absences due to the SEPTA service cuts.**

Attendance Updates

Submitting Notes For Absences - This year, there is a new way to excuse your child's absences. The link to the new form can be found below. Please review the following information:

- When your child is absent, an absent note is required to report the absence.
- You are able to excuse the absence for up to 2 consecutive days with the parent note.
- If your child is absent for a 3rd consecutive day, a note from a medical professional is required.
- Vacations are not considered an excused absence.
- The number of parent excuse notes allowed for the year has been reduced from 10 to 9. Only 9 parent notes are accepted during the entire school year.

Early Dismissals - We understand that early dismissals are necessary at times. Here are some things to keep in mind when seeking an early dismissal:

- Some parts of our day are busier than others, for this reason, we ask that all early dismissals happen before 2pm.
- We cannot accept requests over the telephone for students to leave class early for a pick up unless it is an emergency. This also applies to allow middle school students to travel on their own. Due to safety precautions students must be picked up.
- Students are not allowed to dismiss themselves, even if they are 18 years old. They also will not be released to anyone under 18 years of age or other family members and family friends without parental authorization.
- Students are also not permitted to leave class to request a dismissal from staff.
- Students can only be released to authorized guardians and selected adults that are designated by them. If you have someone other than yourself to you desire to pick up a student and they are not listed as an emergency contact please send email to mwaters@boyslatin.org to identify who is picking up the student and what time they will arrive. ID is required when picking up students
- Parents / authorized adults must come into the building with ID to sign the Early Dismissal Book.

School Breakfast + Lunch

Please ensure that students are arriving to school on time to take advantage of our free breakfast program. Doors open in the morning at 7:30am and breakfast ends at 8:00am.

Uniform Reminders

As a reminder, **ALL STUDENTS** are expected to be in full Spring Uniform beginning on the first day of school, which is Wednesday, August 20th! Full spring uniform includes: Burgundy Polo Shirt with Boys' Latin Logo (*polo shirts must be tucked in at all times*), Khaki Pants, Black dress shoes (*no sneakers*), Black Belt and Black socks. Please be aware that **students are not allowed to come to school out of uniform** and change into their uniform in school. Additionally, **students are not allowed to change their clothes prior to exiting the school** for dismissal. Students must arrive in full uniform and exit in fully uniform. *Please also be reminded that students ARE NOT permitted to wear Crocs to school.*



Regarding gym, you will be notified when your warrior's grade will have gym. Students are only allowed to wear gym uniforms during the marking period when they have gym.
