Kingsway Regional Middle School is excited to offer a wide array of clubs and activities for the upcoming school year. Some clubs will run for a specific season, while others will be available throughout the entire year. To make signing up easy and accessible for everyone, we are using Schoology for online registration.

How to Sign Up For Clubs/Wellness Activities:

1. **Browse Clubs and Activities:** View the list of all available clubs and activities on our website under the "Clubs/Activities" tab. Each listing will have a unique Schoology code.
2. **Join the Club's Schoology Group:**
 - Log in to **Schoology**.
 - Go to the **"Groups"** tab.
 - Click **"My Groups"** in the top right corner.
 - Select **"Join Group"** from the options in the top right.
 - Enter the club's code to join. You can join as many clubs as you're interested in.

3. **Sign Up for a Session:** On the day a club or activity meets, the club advisor will send a **Google Form** to all students who have joined the Schoology group. This form is where you will sign up for that specific after-school session.
4. **Confirm Your Spot:** Complete the Google Form to sign up for the session. Sign-ups are on a first-come, first-served basis and are only open between **7:40 AM and 8:08 AM** during homeroom/arrival.
5. **Finalize Your Plan:** Each session can accommodate up to **30 students**. Once you have secured a spot, remember to contact your family to let them know you'll be staying after school.

PLEASE NOTE:

- *To sign up for a club, you must first "Join" its Schoology group. You can do this at any time throughout the school year.*
- *You are not committed to one club for the entire year. Feel free to participate in multiple clubs and activities that interest you throughout the year.*
- *To ensure all students have an opportunity to participate, please sign up for only **one club or activity per day**.*
- *For a complete list of clubs, visit the middle school website under the "Clubs and Activities" section.*
- ***In accordance with District Policy 5536, parent/guardian consent for participation in the random alcohol and drug testing program is required for all students attending KRMS after-school clubs and wellness activities. Additionally, students must have all obligations met and be in "Good Standing" with the school's discipline code.***
