## **Proposed Projects Overview**

- Critical Needs (Priority): These are immediate, essential projects required to maintain safe, effective, and high-quality learning environments.
- **High Needs** (Important): These projects are important to the continued success of our schools and support growth, innovation, and expanded opportunities for students.
- Future Needs (Revenue-Based): These projects are dependent on future ESPLOST revenue and reflect long-range planning to support continued growth and modernization.

This framework ensures that funding is directed first to the most urgent needs while also planning responsibly for the future.
