This is given at McQueen to every junior in the Spring as well as any senior who has not taken it at least one time.

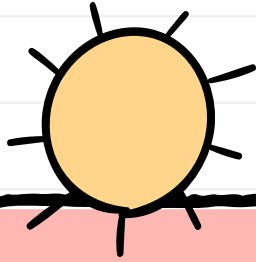

# UNR Scholarship Process

FEBRUARY 15, 2026

Students must have all admissions requirements completed by this date, which automatically places them under consideration for the UNR scholarship program.

MATRIX

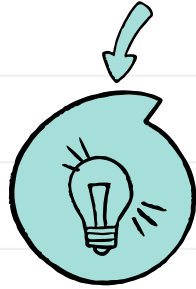
Students must have a qualifying unweighted GPA and ACT/SAT test score under the Scholarship Matrix to receive an award. There is also a GPA-only scholarship opportunity.

AWARDS

Awards vary and are based on a matrix (CO 2026 matrix to be released soon)

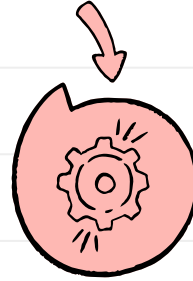
Pack Promise+ covers tuition, fees, and books. Must be Federal Pell Grant eligible and have a Student Aid Index of \$7,000 or less

# TMCC Nevada Promise Scholarship

## WHAT?

As a last-dollar scholarship, the Nevada Promise Scholarship can cover **up to 3 years** of tuition and fees not covered by other gift aid

## WHEN?

The scholarship application due date is **October 31, 2025**. There are additional steps that have separate deadlines after the initial application is completed

# Millennium Scholarship

## GPA

Graduate with an overall GPA of **3.25** (weighted or unweighted)

## CLASSES

While in high school, complete  
**4 English**  
**4 Math (inc. Algebra 2)**  
**3 Science**  
**3 Social Studies**

## RESIDENCY

Be a **resident of Nevada** for at least two years

## TEST SCORES

If GPA requirement is not met, an alternate qualifier is to earn a qualifying test score:  
**ACT 21 or higher**  
**SAT 1070 or higher**

## APPLICATION

There is **not an application** to fill out! WUSD will submit the names of eligible students following graduation

## NOTIFICATION

Award notification will come by mail in **July or August** following high school graduation

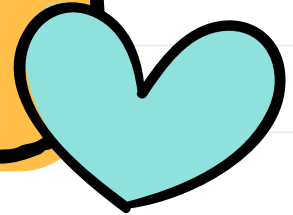
# McQueen General Scholarships

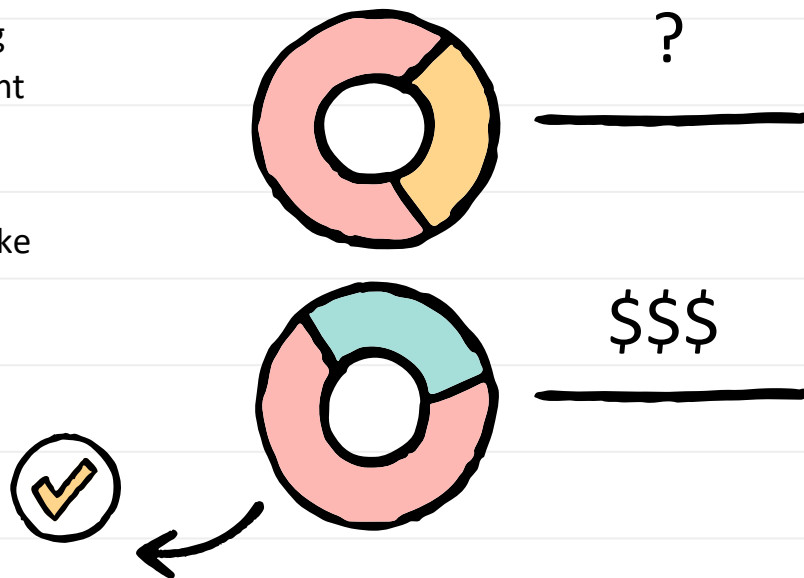


# Senior "To-Do" List

Action Item	Helpful Tips
<b>Research college admissions requirements</b>	What are the admissions criteria? Do you need to write a college essay? Do you need letters of recommendation?
<b>Start applying to your college(s) of choice</b>	For out-of-state institutions, consider using the Common App. The Common App is used by over 1,000 colleges and universities.
<b>Send official transcripts</b>	Counselors will upload transcripts to the Common App and SendEDU only. All others must be ordered through Scrib Order. Students get four FREE transcripts per year
<b>Send test scores</b>	Students must send their ACT, SAT, or AP test scores directly from <a href="http://www.act.org">www.act.org</a> or <a href="http://www.collegeboard.org">www.collegeboard.org</a> to their college(s) of choice
<b>Take placement tests</b>	If ACT/SAT test scores did not place a student in their desired math or English class in college, taking a placement test at their school of choice may help
<b>Complete the FAFSA</b>	Students must list at least one college/university to receive their FAFSA
<b>Search for scholarship opportunities</b>	Check out websites such as <a href="http://www.fastweb.com">www.fastweb.com</a> , <a href="http://www.goingmerry.com">www.goingmerry.com</a> , or <a href="http://www.bigfuture.collegeboard.org">www.bigfuture.collegeboard.org</a> to search for additional scholarship opportunities
<b>Apply for scholarships</b>	Keep deadlines in mind to give yourself plenty of time to complete all the requirements
<b>Check grades</b>	Stay on top of your grades during senior year. Download the Infinite Campus Student app to stay informed

# Free Application for Federal Student aid

- College-bound students need to complete the FAFSA to determine if they are eligible for federal aid, including grants, scholarships, student employment, and student loans
- Many colleges use information from the FAFSA to make **in-house financial aid decisions** (aka institutional aid)
- UNR and TMCC both require the FAFSA
- Application opens on October 1, 2025
- Complete the **2026-2027 FAFSA**

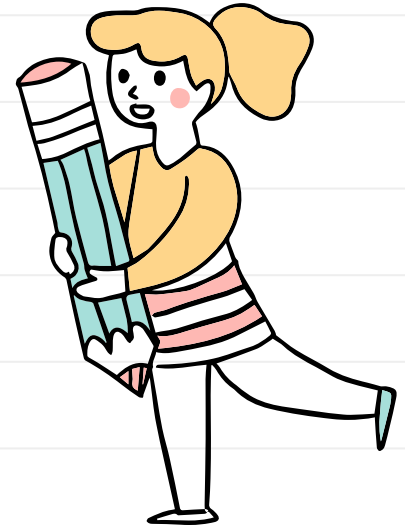
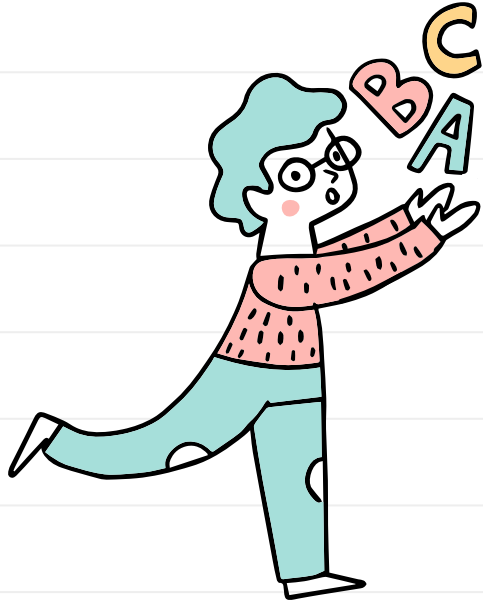

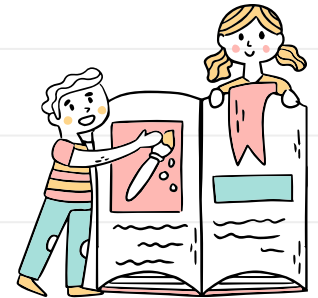
