## Membership Requirements

To join NEHS, students must:

- Be a junior or senior in high school
- Complete 2 English courses
- Maintain a minimum overall GPA of 3.0
- Demonstrate excellence in English coursework with a minimum grade of 3.0 in any English course
- Show strong character, leadership, and commitment to service





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## Membership Dues

- One-Time Individual Student Membership Fee: \$20
- Students receive an official membership certificate and gain access to all NEHS student awards, grants, and scholarships throughout their high school career
