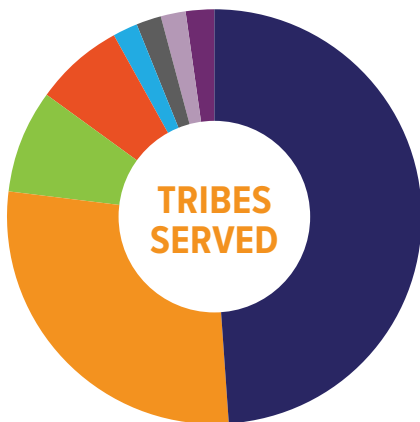


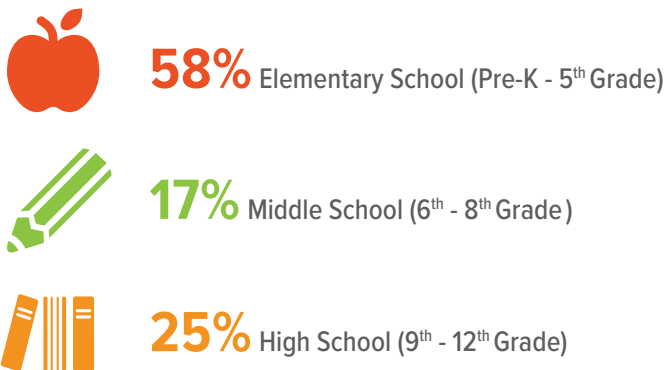
WHO ARE NATIVE AMERICAN LEARNERS IN TULSA PUBLIC SCHOOLS? *
