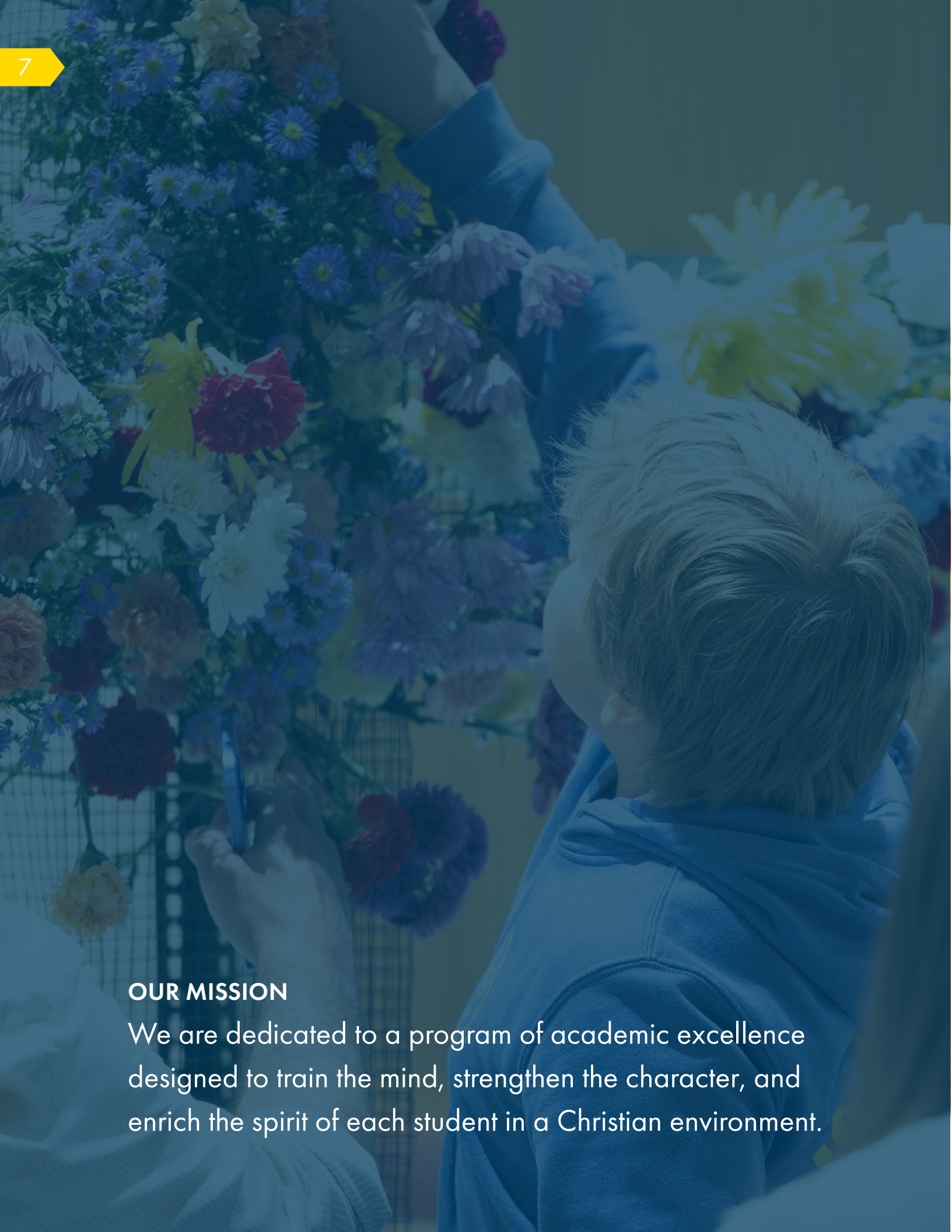

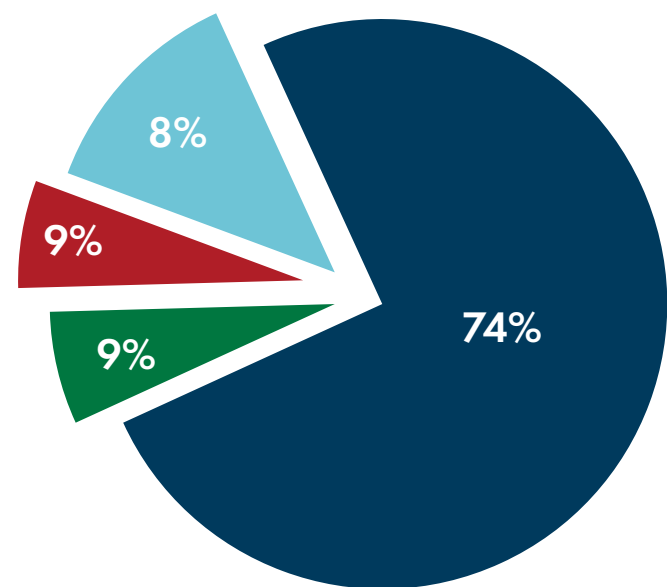

# FINANCIAL OVERVIEW

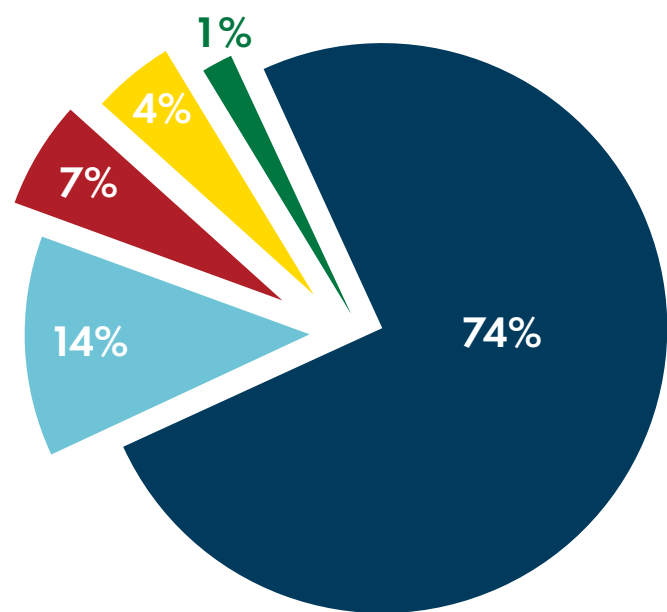

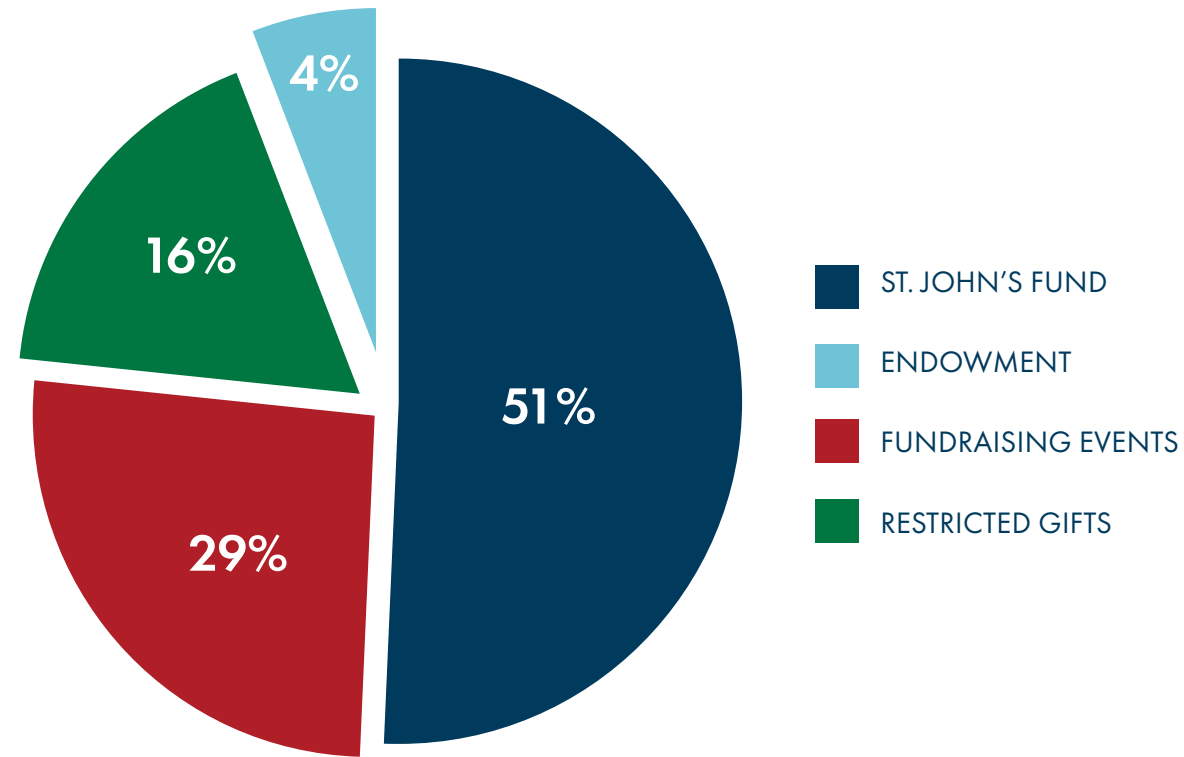

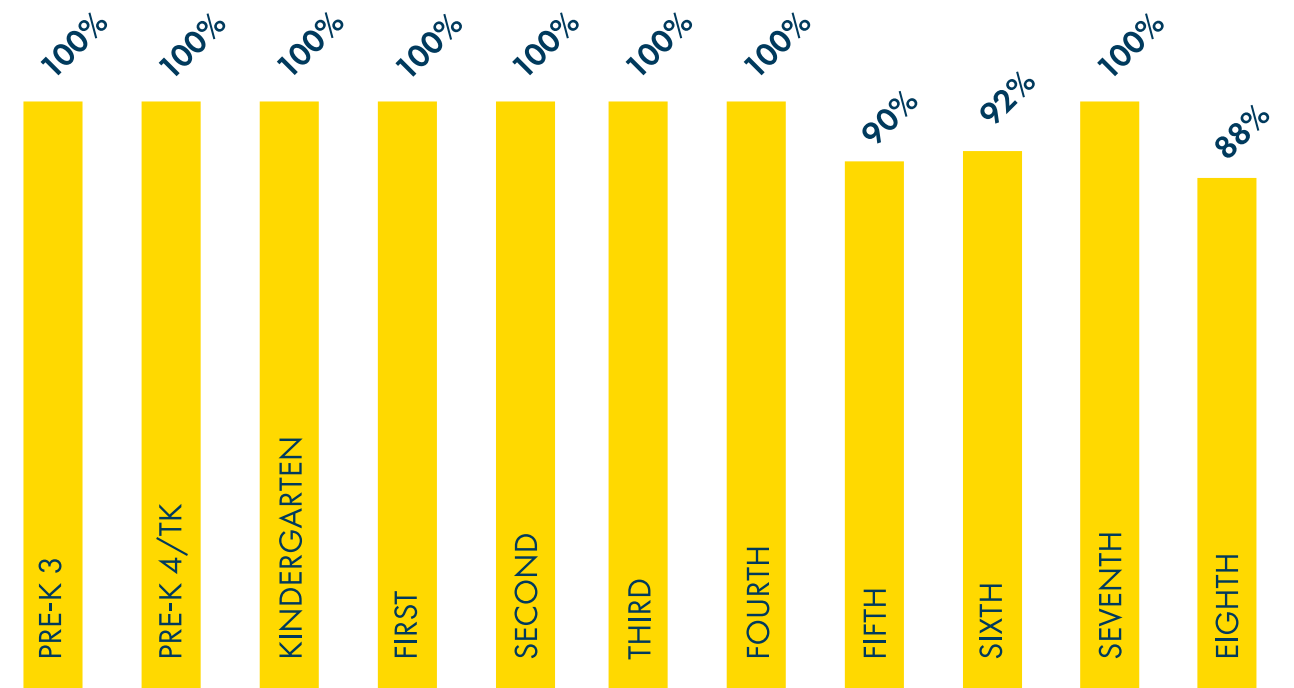
## PARENT PARTICIPATION IN THE ST. JOHN'S FUND AND 8TH GRADE GIFT CAMPAIGN

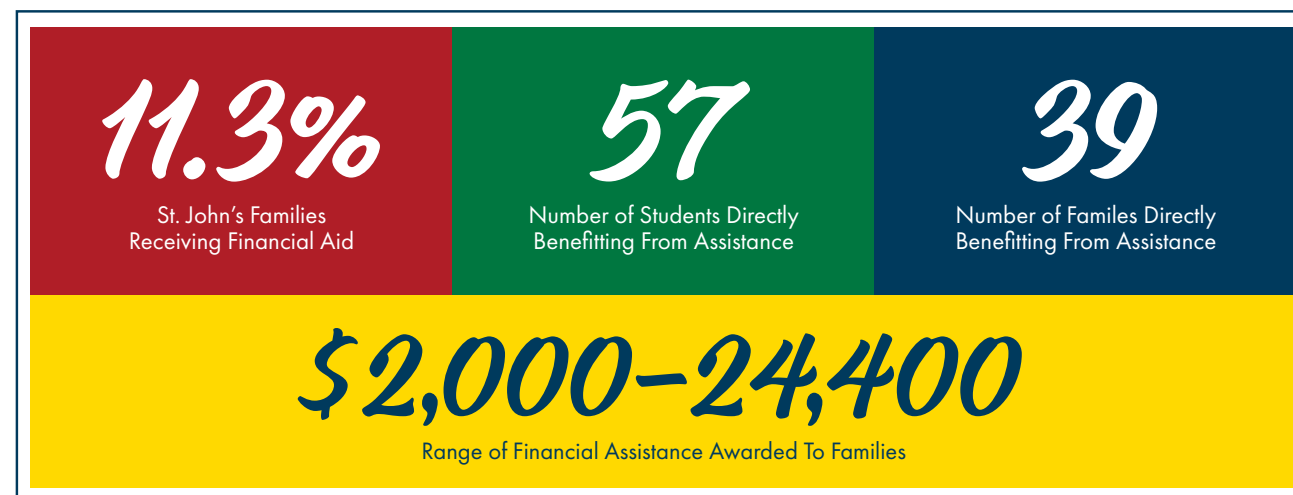
