

Over the past seven years, I have been fortunate to build a dual career in coaching and education, rooted in success both on the field and in the classroom. My journey has been defined by a passion for developing young people and making a lasting impact on their lives.

My coaching career began with Flag Football at Desert Sands FNL, where I spent five years shaping young athletes and establishing my identity as a leader. While winning a league championship in 2021 was a proud moment, my greatest accomplishments were the relationships I built with parents and the growth I fostered in my players as individuals. In 2020, I began coaching 7-on-7 football, achieving five tournament championships by the time I finished in 2022. These experiences solidified my reputation as a coach who not only builds championship-caliber teams but also places unwavering emphasis on the personal growth and holistic development of every athlete under my guidance.

The height of my coaching career has been my tenure in youth tackle football, where I achieved unprecedented success in the highly competitive Southern California Junior All-American Football Conference. Over four seasons (2021-2024), I amassed a 39-6 record, including a dominant 22-1 run during my final two years at the Division 1 level. Under my leadership, my teams earned three consecutive Super Bowl appearances (2022, 2023, 2024) and made history by securing back-to-back championships in 2023 and 2024—a first for a coach in the Coachella Valley at the Division 1 level.

Additionally, I hold a perfect 3-0 record in the Desert Elite Showcase, an annual All-Star game highlighting the area's top talent. These achievements are a reflection of not only my dedication but also the commitment of the players, coaches, and families I've been fortunate to work with.

Simultaneously, I've been building a career in education with Palm Springs Unified School District. Over the past four years, I've worked as a resident substitute before transitioning into my current role as a resident teacher. I am concurrently pursuing a master's degree in education with an education specialist credential, which I will complete in June 2025. This academic journey has deepened my understanding of how to support diverse learners and foster inclusive environments for all students.

Whether on the field or in the classroom, I approach my work with the belief that I'm coaching/teaching life."
