### What is the Governor's Honors Program (GHP)?

The Georgia Governor's Honors Program (GHP) is a residential summer program for skilled, knowledgeable, and talented high school juniors and seniors. GHP offers instruction that is significantly different from the typical high school classroom and is designed to provide students with academic, cultural, and social enrichment necessary to become the next generation of global critical thinkers, innovators, and leaders.

### Prospective GHP students should know that selection to the Governor's Honors Program is highly competitive.

Students should have passion in the area of nomination, desire to attend GHP in the summer, willingness/ability to live in a residential setting for the full-length of the program, and the capacity to be fully engaged in the curriculum for the duration of the program. This is the minimum threshold for consideration for the program. The most successful student candidates additionally have the attributes, experiences, and skills outlined in the selection criteria provided for their area of nomination.

If you are interested in GHP, speak with a current or past teacher in the nomination area of interest and ask them to submit a nomination form for you. **Teacher nominations are due by 4:00 pm on Tuesday, September 9<sup>th</sup>.**
