Amanda Jones, Louisiana school librarian and educator of 24 years, was the 2021 School Library Journal Co-Librarian of the Year, a 2021 Library Journal Mover and Shaker, and the 2020 Louisiana Librarian of the Year. Amanda presents at the national and international level on the importance of certified school librarians, book joy, and why every child deserves to see themselves reflected in the books on library shelves. For her courageous work speaking out against the pro-censorship movement, Amanda has received numerous intellectual freedom awards from the American Library Association, American Association of School Librarians, and Louisiana Library Association for her dedication to eradicating censorship and promoting libraries in Louisiana. She is a founding member of two organizations, Louisiana Citizens Against Censorship and Librarians Building Libraries.
