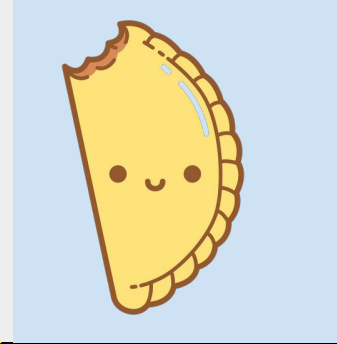
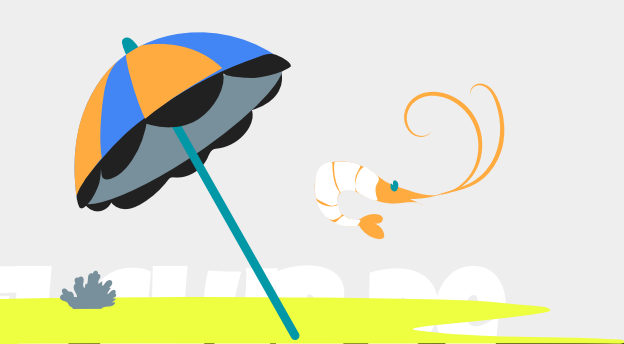

The Yearbook Club is an opportunity for students from all three grade levels to participate in the design and production of the Westlake Middle School's annual yearbook.

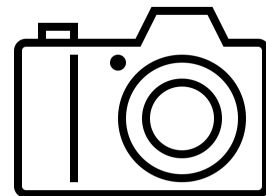

WMS MUSICAL

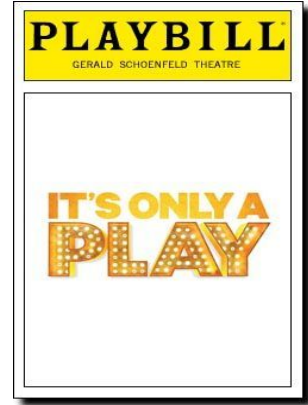
