NOTICE OF NONDISCRIMINATION

National Technical Honor Society (NTHS) Student Eligibility

Students must be given the opportunity to participate if they qualify. It is also the responsibility of the nominating teacher to be sure the scholastic data and requirements are met **prior to submitting the paperwork**.

- Candidates can only be nominated once. If a student has been inducted in the past, please do not submit their name again.
- 10th through 12th grade students are eligible
- Have a **cumulative overall** GPA of 3.0 or higher (You can obtain GPAs from your Registrar.)
- Will have completed 180 hours, or 1 year of a CTE class
- Demonstrate scholastic achievement
- Show progress in skill and knowledge development
- Exhibit pride in themselves and in their work
- Demonstrate honesty, responsibility, and dependability
- Have the ability to work well with others
- Show leadership, and good citizenship



FutureForward Bollman Lettering Student Eligibility

Students must earn a 3.5 Grade point average Semester 1 and Quarter 3 combined to qualify for a Letter in their Career & Technical Education course. See table below for qualifying grades.
