- CV students will have the opportunity to run the bases after the game because the Stormers now allow ALL children to run the bases after every Sunday game!

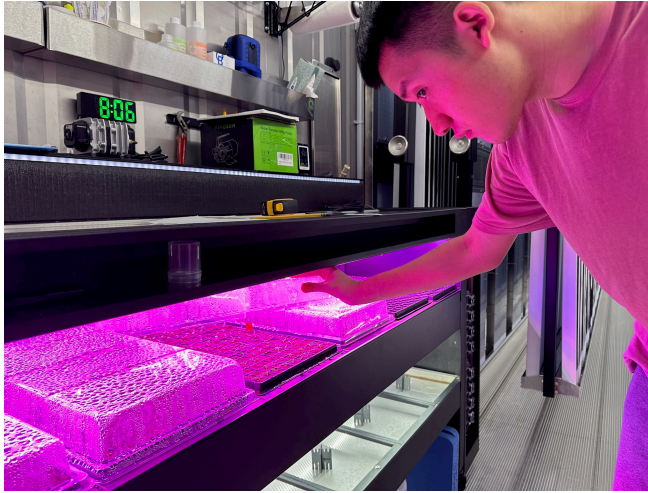

Don't Miss Out: SAT, PSAT Info

Baby Buckskin Program



CV will host the SATs on the following dates:

- Oct. 4 (registration deadline: Sept. 19)
- Nov. 8 (registration deadline: Oct. 24)
- Dec. 6 (registration deadline: Nov 21)
- March 14 (registration deadline: Feb. 27)
- May 2 (registration deadline: Apr. 17)

Students create an account, register, and pay at collegeboard.org. Doors open at 7:30 a.m. and the exam begins at 8 a.m.

In addition, CV is hosting the PSAT (practice SAT) on **Saturday, October 11th at 7:30 a.m.** The test is offered only once per year and is not required to take the SAT.

Students who would like to take the PSAT should bring a \$25 check or money order payable to Conestoga Valley to the counseling office by Sept. 16. The test is digital so students must bring their charged iPad.
