### **PARMA CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT GOALS**

1. By the end of the 2025-2026 school year, 100% of our educators will implement our "Elevating the Essentials" instructional playbook to teach board-adopted curriculum resources which are aligned with Ohio Department of Education and Workforce standards. The focus will produce a 5% increase in OST data, 5% increase in benchmark data (Fall 2025 to Spring 2026), and 3% increase in graduation rate.
2. By the end of the 2025-2026 school year, 100% of our educators will incorporate daily read, write, and discuss prompts connected to authentic literacy strategies to produce by a 5% increase in OST data, 5% increase in benchmark data (Fall 2025 to Spring 2026), and a 3% increase in graduation rate.
3. By the end of the 2025-2026 school year, 100% of our educators will utilize assessments (and whenever possible, common assessments) connected to ODEW standards and will adjust instruction to meet the needs of diverse learners as measured by a 5% increase in OST data, 5% increase in benchmark data (Fall 2025 to Spring 2026), and a 3% increase in graduation rate.
