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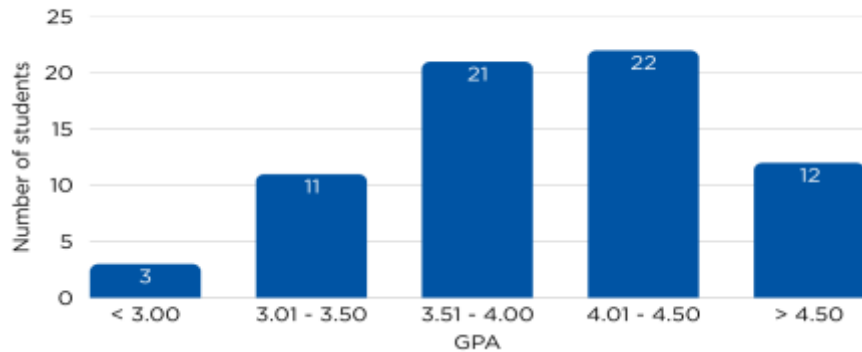

Honors (H), Advanced Placement (AP), and Post-AP

- **Honors Courses** precede or follow AP courses, require faculty approval, and are conducted at rigor equivalent to AP.
- **AP Courses** follow Honors courses and require faculty approval. Students in AP courses are required to take the AP exam.
- **Post-AP Courses** are college-level, use college textbooks and syllabi, and require that students have successfully completed the preceding AP course and exam.

Grade Weighting

Honors, AP, and Post-AP courses all receive +1 point in GPA calculations.

Class Rank

Cincinnati Country Day School does not rank its students.

Standard Course Load

A standard course load is 5.5 credits per year.

Grading Scale and Graduation Requirements

Full-year course = 1.0 credit. Semester-long course = 0.5 credit.
