Grade 4 students took time out of the classroom to explore the City of London and discover Roman Londinium. They visited the Guildhall Art Gallery where they viewed the entrance to an amphitheatre unearthed during the gallery's construction. The students were intrigued to tour other sites where artifacts had been uncovered during excavation work. They saw the ruins of a Roman temple to the god Mithras, and viewed a reconstruction of a water wheel. Many of the discoveries are now housed in the Roman Gallery at the Museum of London where the students ended their day. The displays illustrate how people from that period dressed, cooked, prayed, traded and even how they buried their dead.
