The School

Established in September 1947, St. Thomas Aguinas Catholic School is now the largest PreK-8 school not only in the Catholic Diocese of Dallas but also in the state of Texas. The School had humble beginnings serving as an extension to the families of the Sacred Heart Cathedral. Known initially as Sacred Heart School #2, St. Thomas Aguinas opened its doors with 250 students in four classrooms with the Sisters of Divine Providence as the first teaching Order at the school. Today, the School serves approximately 550 families and maintains an enrollment of nearly 900 students.

St. Thomas Aquinas has seen impressive development over its 75 years as seen by its two National Blue Ribbon School of Excellence Awards, the expansion to two campuses, and its exceptional grounds and facilities. STA provides a rigorous academic program rooted in the liberal arts, developing strong communications skills, problem-solving, and critical thinking. The School provides robust student-life experiences with a host of opportunities for fellowship, leadership, and pursuing individual interests. Its technology-rich environment incorporates computer labs on both campuses and 1:1 laptop devices for Grades 6-8.

Central to the mission of STA is the spiritual growth of its students. Catholic ideals are an integral part of all instruction, whether through the classroom or through opportunities to grow in faith and servant leadership. With a motto of KNOW IT, SHOW IT, LIVE IT, the School firmly believes that formation of students in the Catholic faith would not be complete without teaching them to live that faith in their everyday lives.
