## The IB Diploma Program

The curriculum at ACST for 11th and 12th graders is based on the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (DP) which is respected worldwide for its academic challenge, emphasis on personal development, and preparation for university-level study. Internationally-recognized course outcomes require students to not only know the what, but also to explore the why and how of their subject, which strengthens analytical thinking, deepens understanding, and encourages meaningful connections across disciplines.

Teaching and learning in the DP focuses on integrating content-specific knowledge and skills alongside life skills, such as collaboration, communication, and flexible thinking, that students need for navigating ever-changing academic, professional, and personal landscapes.

At ACST, the IBDP's international outlook is enriched by our globally diverse community. Course content and classroom discussions explore a wide range of cultures and histories, helping students develop empathy and a deeper understanding of different perspectives. In doing so, they open doors to new ideas, hearts to others' experiences, and minds to the richness of the global community.

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# Learning Support at ACST

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## **Inclusive & Empowering**

ACST is committed to fostering a diverse, equitable, and welcoming learning environment in which every student—regardless of background or ability—can thrive. Through a “community of belonging,” the school celebrates individuality while promoting empathy, respect, and authentic inclusion.

## **Holistic Student Support Services**

ACST’s Student Support Services encompass four key areas to ensure every learner is supported academically, socially, and emotionally:

- English as an Additional Language (EAL): Tailored support for multilingual learners working toward full English proficiency.
- Learning Support: Targeted assistance for students needing help with core academic subjects.
- Counseling: Social-emotional support delivered through counseling programs.
- Full-Time Educational Psychologist: Provides academic, behavioral, and mental health support—including assessments, short-term counseling, and interventions.

All these services are delivered collaboratively with homeroom and subject teachers to ensure personalized, high-quality support.

## **Student-Centered Collaboration**

The Student Support Services team works closely with families and educators to create individualized pathways to success—whether for language acquisition, learning needs, or emotional resilience.

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## Co-curricular Activities

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Supporting students' passions is fundamental to our educational philosophy at ACST. We offer a diverse array of after-school activities, clubs, competition teams, and organizations designed to enrich students' experiences, foster personal growth, and strengthen our learning community.
