### Associate Head of School for Teaching and Learning


Responsible for delivering an early education – 12th grade learning, design, pedagogy, and curriculum assessment that drives outcomes

### Head of Lower School

Responsible, with the support of Lower School Administrative Team, for the overall development of students in the Lower School, including curriculum, assessment, and extracurricular programming

### Assistant Head of Lower School

- Oversees programs, events, and communications to foster parent and larger community partnerships that further the mission of the School
- Collaborates with faculty to map and develop curriculum by unit to ensure vertical alignment in curricular outcomes
- Identifies opportunities for cross-disciplinary learning
- Oversees the Associate Teacher Mentoring Program



### Lead Teacher

Acts as the primary point of contact for information regarding a particular course, including grading policies, curriculum, student-teacher relationship, etc.

### Learning Specialist & Math Specialist

- Works in small groups to deliver targeted instruction that meets each student's unique learning profile and academic goals
- Collaborates with the Child Study Team (CST) to identify and respond to individual student needs

### Student Success Team

- Provides student support services to advance student learning in one-on-one or group settings
