**Associate Head of School for Student Life**


Responsible for delivering an early childhood – 12th grade holistic experience that provides for the spiritual and leadership development of students

**Head of Lower School**

Responsible, with the support of Lower School Administrative Team, for the overall development of students in the Lower School, including curriculum, social/emotional well-being, and spiritual growth

**Assistant Head of Lower School**

- Oversees programs, events, and communications to foster parent and larger community partnerships that further the mission of the School
- Collaborates with the Child Study Team (CST) to identify and respond to individual student needs
- When needed, assists lead teachers with Lower School disciplinary issues



**Lead Teacher**

- Responsible for enhancing the quality of life in all non-academic/co-curricular areas
- Manages Lower School disciplinary issues
- Oversees the daily events in the Lower School, including the general decorum and behavior of students

**School Psychologist & Learning Specialist**

- Supports the overall social/emotional health and growth of students in the Lower School
- Provides direct support to students and collaborates with school administration, faculty, parents, and outside professionals as needed
- Collaborates with the Child Study Team (CST) to offer professional support and to ensure that programming and interventions meet the social/emotional needs of the student body
