Associate Head of School for Teaching and Learning

Responsible for delivering an early education – 12th grade learning, design, pedagogy, and curriculum assessment that drives outcomes

Head of Middle School

- Responsible, with the support of the Middle School Administrative Team, for the overall development of students in the Middle School, including their engagement with curriculum, spiritual growth, arts, athletics, and extracurriculars
- Oversees the faculty, curriculum, student assessments, and grading practices with the Department Chairs and instructional leaders.

Assistant Head of Middle School for Student Life

- Oversees programs, events, and communications to foster parent and larger community partnerships that further the mission of the School
- Acts as a liaison with communications and special events teams

Department Chairs/Instructional Leaders

Oversees the faculty, curriculum, grading, and placement policies within the specific department
