Sacred Heart Greenwich supports the academic success of each student through individualized and programmatic resources. Below is a guide on resources and who to contact when support is needed.

Associate Head of School for Teaching and Learning

Responsible for delivering an early education – 12th grade learning, design, pedagogy, and curriculum assessment that drives outcomes

Head of Upper School

- Responsible, with the support of Upper School Administrative Team, for the overall development of students in the Upper School, including academics, spiritual growth, arts, athletics and extracurriculars
- Oversees the faculty, curriculum, student assessments, and grading practices with the Department Chairs

Department Chairs

Oversees the faculty, curriculum, grading and placement policies within specific department

Teacher

Acts as the primary point of contact for information regarding a particular course, including grading policies, curriculum, student-teacher relationship, etc.

Advisor

- Monitors the academic program, service projects, extracurricular interests, social life and well-being of each advisee
- Supports each advisee by assisting in problem solving, celebrating successes, and bringing larger concerns to the attention of the Academic Dean or Head of Upper School

Academic Deans

- Oversees the progress and monitors each student's academic program in light of ability, interests, requirements, and unique needs
- Assists students in navigating academic responsibilities and fostering academic growth
- Collaborates with students, teachers, advisors, and other Upper School Administrative Team members to support each student's program of study

• Collaborates with students, parents and teachers to address areas of concern

Student Success Team

- Provides student support services to advance student learning in one-on-one or group settings
