Be sure to check the grade requirements listed for each club. Grade 13 is one year past high school.

Beekeeping Club

(Grades K - 13)

What's the buzz about bees? Using beeswax, make projects such as candles and lip balm. Cook some tasty treats with honey. Learn about beekeeping, bee behavior, and the importance of pollinators.

Chinese Culture Club

(Grades K - 13)

Study the depth and diversity of Chinese culture, language, and arts - then share what you've learned through public demonstrations and exhibits. Members of this club must enroll in Raritan Valley Chinese School in the fall.

Coding "STEP" Club

(Grades 2 - 8)

Crack the code to creativity! Learn coding and game creation using MIT Scratch. This virtual STEP (Short Term Exploratory Program) club meets once a week for 6 sessions.

Cooking Club (New)

(Grades K - 3)

(Grades K - 8)
