# FERPA

## (Family Educational Rights & Privacy Act)

- Prohibits disclosure of information from a student's education records
- HVCC will not discuss a student's account with a parent over the phone or in person unless the student has authorized the college to release the information to that party and that party has the student's FERPA password
- The form must be notarized prior to mailing it to HVCC
- The form should be mailed to the HVCC Registrar's Office or given to the program to send
- Keep a copy of the form as it has the password on it

# Grant Information

- Students must stay in the pathway they chose at the end of sophomore year (some flexibility if the courses already taken also apply to new major chosen)
- Students are not eligible for financial aid while under P-TECH since P-TECH covers cost of textbooks, tuition & fees, parking
- Students have up to 2 years post senior year to complete. Most students finish in the first year.
- P-TECH will only cover the retaking of 1 class and does not cover remediation classes.
- Cybersecurity/ Engineering- students must have a “C” or better in each CISS course in order to move on to the next.
- Students will not apply to HVCC, but will meet with an advisor and transition through our program.

# Internet Enabled Devices

Cybersecurity	Algebra & Geometry
Surgical Tech	Algebra, Biology, Chemistry taken as a junior
