Cov Ntawv Tshaj Qhia Txog Tus Tub Ntxhais Kawm Ntawv Ib Tug Kheej (los sis ISRs) yog tau tsim tawm los rau txhua tus tub ntxhais kawm ntawv uas xav tias yuav tuaj xeeb ntawv thoob plaws lub xeev. ISR muab cov ntaub ntawv qhia paub txog koj tus tub ntxhais kawm qhov kev kawm tau zoo thiab kawm paub txog Minnesota Cov Qauv Cai Fab Kev Kawm.

- The student responds incorrectly to the task after the test administrator has provided additional support = **1 point**
- The student does not respond to the task or the student's response is unrelated to the task = **0 points**
