# UNIVERSAL SCREENING & DIAGNOSTIC


- Determines a student's overall academic performance level
- Identifies students who may benefit from additional services or supports
- Identifies student strengths and weaknesses
- Pinpoints specific learning needs to guide academic curricular and instructional decisions
- Monitors student growth

# OTHER ASSESSMENTS

## STANDARDIZED CRITERION-REFERENCED ASSESSMENTS


- Evaluates learning at the end of a long - term instructional period (e.g., end of course or grade)
- Determines whether each student has achieved proficiency on a set of required skills and concepts
- Should not be used as a grade except as required by state law (EOC- counting 20% of student's final grade)

## STANDARDIZED NORM-REFERENCED ASSESSMENTS

- Evaluate students on broad areas of knowledge
- Serve to classify or rank students on a continuum of achievement compared to their peers
- Not used as a grade
