Class Dojo and Communicating with Your Child's Teacher and School





Schoology is an improved learning management system for schools that enables its users to create, manage, and share assignments and resources. The cloud-based platform provides tools to manage classrooms and blended learning. Students used Performance Matters (within Schoology) to take assessments last year. 
