SUFFICIENCY OF PUPIL TEXTBOOK AND INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS COMPLIANCE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025-26

Education Code Section 60119 - SB550 Williams Settlement

WHEREAS, the governing board of Victor Valley Union High School District, in order to comply with the requirements of Education Code Section 60119 held a public hearing on Thursday, September 11th, 2025 at 5:30 p.m., which did not take place during or immediately following school hours, and;

WHEREAS, the governing board provided at least ten days' notice of the public hearing posted in at least three public places within the district that stated the time, place and purpose of the hearing, and:

WHEREAS, the governing board encouraged participation by parents, teachers, members of the community, and bargaining unit leaders in the public hearings, and;

WHEREAS, information provided at the public hearing and to the governing board at the public meeting detailed the extent to which textbooks and instructional materials were provided to all students, including English Learners, in the district, and;

WHEREAS, the definition of "sufficient textbooks or instructional materials" mean that each pupil has a textbook or instructional materials, or both, to use in class and to take home, and;

WHEREAS, sufficient textbooks or instructional materials were provided to each student, including English Learners, that are aligned to the academic content standards and consistent with the cycles and content of the curriculum frameworks in the following subjects: Mathematics, Science, History/ Social Science, English/ Language Arts, including the English Language Development component of the adopted program;

WHEREAS, sufficient textbooks or instructional materials were provided to each pupil enrolled in world language and;

WHEREAS, laboratory science equipment was available for science laboratory classes in grades 9-12, inclusive;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that for the 2025-2026 school year, the Victor Valley Union High School District has provided each pupil with sufficient textbooks and instructional materials aligned to the academic content standards and consistent with the cycles and content of the curriculum frameworks.
