## **Morning Drop Off & After School Pick Up**

#### Important Update for this year...

Drop off at school (including breakfast) begins at 8:40 this year. It is important that students <u>do not arrive at school before 8:40</u> (unless waiting with a parent/guardian) as we do not have supervision and it creates a safety concern. For walkers/bike riders; we are asking some students who are arriving early to wait and leave their home a few minutes later! Safety is our top priority - so we appreciate your support and cooperation. Classrooms open at 8:55am, and the school day begins (tardy bell rings) at 9:00am.

- If you are picking up your child in the car line, enter the line from Ohio street driving west. Vehicles will <u>not</u> be allowed to "cut the line" by driving straight across the 3-way stop or entering the line from the east (turning left into the school at the stop sign).
- If your child needs help getting buckled up (especially our younger students) please park in the lower lot and walk up to meet them. Parents should not exit their vehicle in the curbside pickup. We need to keep the line moving in order to not block the 3-way intersection by the entrance to campus.

#### **Reminder for Families: Smart Watches**

Reminder: Smart watches operate much like cell phones and both are not allowed during school hours due to the distraction they pose in the classroom. Students are expected to put them in their backpck during the school day. District policy states that these devices must be checked into the office upon arrival and picked up at dismissal - however at Robert Gray we are willing to allow students to keep them in backpacks as long as they can manage that responsibility, and only require students to check them into the office on a case-by-case basis. I understand the conveneince of communicating with your student via cell phone or smart watch and the desire to be able to "track" your child before and after school; however to ensure safety and proper communication with the adults at school, if you need to get a message to your child during school hours, espeically when it comes to changes in dismissal plans - please call the office and we'll make sure your child and the teacher are informed.

## Winter weather and recess at school:

As fall approaches and the weather begins to change, please remember that we go outside for recess 3 times a day! Please help your child remember weather-appropriate shoes and jackets so they can enjoy recess and be comfortable when they return to their learning. You are welcome to pack boots/extra clothes in your child's backpack, as we do not have extra clothing at school due to rainy weather, but will try to call home for dry clothes as needed.



We also have resources to support your family if you are in need of jackets or shoes. Please call the school, e-mail our counselor Ms. Halleck, or click the Family & Community Resource Center button below.

In general, we go outside when it is raining - and only stay indoors if the weather conditions are determined to be unsafe according to our <u>Weather Guidelines for Children</u> or <u>Children and Youth Activities Guide for Air Quality</u>.
