

8 FACTS *about* MICRO-CREDENTIALS

Definition

What are micro-credentials?

A micro-credential is a short, competency –based recognition that allows an educator to develop and demonstrate mastery in a particular area. Each micro-credential is short and focused on a narrow range of skills and competencies.

Who can enroll?

Micro-credentials are free to all Richland One employees. Both certified and classified staff can sign up for an account and enroll in micro-credentials.

Cost

Micro-credentials are free to Richland One Employees. There is no cost and no materials to purchase.

Time

How long does a micro-credential take?

The time it takes to complete a micro-credential varies by individual. Micro-credentials are completely self-paced and can be completed in as little as a few a days or much as a couple months.

Support

While you are enrolled in a micro-credential, the district has a team of educators available to support you through the process. The team of support people are called Collaborators. Collaborators are available to you via email, Teams and F2F meetings for support.

Recertification

You will earn 12 recertification points for every micro-credential earned. You will be awarded a certificate of completion that will document points earned.

Is there a limit?

You may enroll in up to two micro-credentials at one time. Once you have successfully earned those two micro-credentials, you may enroll in two more. There is no limit to how many micro-credentials you may complete.
