Method of Computing GPA:

LCHS does not add any weighting to numerical grades on the transcript or to the Cumulative Unweighted GPA.

The Cumulative Weighted GPA includes only academic courses. For this GPA, .5 points are added to 4.0 scale for Honors Classes and Academic Dual Enrollment courses; 1.0 points added to 4.0 scale for AP classes.

Class Rank is based on the Academic Cumulative Weighted GPA and includes all students in the grade level.
