#### COMMUNITY

Wyoming, a northern Cincinnati suburb, is an upper-middle class residential community with a population of approximately 8,300 residents. The majority of the residents are college graduates who hold executive and professional positions in the greater Cincinnati area. The Wyoming student body reflects varied ethnic, religious, and racial backgrounds. Wyoming High has been ranked as one of the top high schools in the nation by *US News and World Report*, *The Washington Post*, and *Newsweek*. There is a long tradition of a dedication to excellence and the education of the whole student. Historically, 96% of graduates pursue a Bachelor's degree or an Associate's degree. Additionally, 3% pursue employment and/or military, and 1% pursue gap-year opportunities.

#### GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Wyoming High School requires a rigorous academic program for all its students. Included among the graduation requirements are **four** credits in English, **four** credits in Mathematics, **three** credits in Science, and **four** credits in Social Studies. In addition, all Wyoming High School students must complete required courses in Health, Physical Education, Oral Communications, and Financial Literacy. While not a graduation requirement, the importance of the Fine and/or Performing Arts and World Language are emphasized for all students.

## CLASS RANK AND ADVANCED COURSEWORK

Wyoming High School does not rank its students. Since relative weights are assigned to the courses, the maximum grade point average varies with the subjects selected by the students. All Honors classes and semester-long AP courses receive an additional weight of .045 added onto the base GPA. All year-long AP and *approved* College Credit Plus courses receive an additional weight of .09 added onto the base GPA.

**Honors:** Honors World Studies, Honors American Government and Economic Liberty, Honors Modern World History I and II, Honors Anatomy and Physiology, Honors Biology, Honors Chemistry, Honors Algebra II, Honors Geometry, Honors Pre-Calculus, Honors English 9 and 10. Effective '25-26 SY, Modern World History I and II will replace World Studies and American Government and Economic Liberty.

**AP Courses:** AP Art (2D, 3D, Drawing), AP Biology, AP Calculus AB and BC, AP Chemistry, AP Comparative Government, AP Computer Science A, AP Computer Science Principles, AP Environmental Science, AP European History, AP French, AP Human Geography, AP Language, AP Latin, AP Literature, AP Macroeconomics, AP Microeconomics, AP Music Theory, AP Physics 1, AP Physics C, AP Psychology, AP Seminar, AP Spanish Language and Culture, AP Spanish Literature, AP Statistics, AP US Government and Politics, AP US History. In addition, students have the opportunity to take college courses off-site or online through the State of Ohio's College Credit Plus Program.
