2. The performance period shall be fifty (50) calendar days from the date of issuance of the Purchase Order.

SUBSTITUTION REQUESTS:

1. **Approved Substitutions:** The following surfacing systems are approved as acceptable alternatives to the originally specified Novasurface system, provided all conditions below are met:
 - a. AT Sports Surfacing System
 - b. Acrytech Surfacing System
 - c. APT Laykold
2. **Conditions of Approval:** Approval is contingent on the following:
 - a. **Warranty Requirements:** The manufacturer and/or installer must provide written warranties that meet or exceed the following:

Three (3) year warranty on all crack repair materials and surfacing materials

Three (3) year workmanship warranty from the installer

If any component of the proposed system (e.g. line paint) has a standard warranty period less than 3 years, the contractor must extend the warranty via installer or manufacturer endorsement to meet the project's 3-year requirement.
3. **Submittals and Documentation:** Prior to installation, the contractor must submit the following for final review and file:
 - a. Manufacturer technical data sheets (TDS) for all proposed materials
 - b. Manufacturer-signed warranty certificates matching above terms
 - c. Installer certification or confirmation of manufacturer-approved applicator status

CLARIFICATIONS / RESPONSES TO BIDDER QUESTIONS:

QUESTION 1: Just to clarify, what does the District mean by "thickness of a nickel" for cracks in the bid? Does this refer to all cracks that are wider than the actual thickness of a nickel (2mm) or the width of a nickel (21mm)?

District's Response 1: The term "thickness of a nickel" refers to the actual thickness of a U.S. nickel coin, which is approximately 2 millimeters (mm). Therefore, large cracks are defined as those with an opening approximately 2 mm or wider.

QUESTION 2: When the bid manual refers to a "crack repair system" for larger cracks, is this referring to a fabric system such as RiteWay or Armor?

District's Response 2: A "crack repair system" refers to a fabric-based system or other approved crack repair products designed to reinforce and seal large cracks. Both RiteWay and Armor are approved fabric-reinforced crack repair systems designed to seal and stabilize large cracks in the tennis courts before resurfacing.

QUESTION 3: Irmo High School: Listed as 34,320 square feet

During a recent site visit, I measured the six tennis courts at Irmo High School and found the dimensions to be 120' x 360', which totals **43,200 square feet**. Could you please confirm that this discrepancy will be addressed through a formal addendum?

District's Response 3: Per the Scope of Work (Page 12 of the Solicitation), The approximate total measurements of the tennis courts at each location were provided. All measurements referenced in this bid are approximate. The contractor is responsible for making field measurements prior to submitting their bid. Prospective bidders are encouraged to inspect the sites prior to submitting bids.

QUESTION 4: What is the anticipated time line for the work to be completed at each high School?

District's Response 3: The performance period shall be fifty (50) calendar days from the date of issuance of the Purchase Order.
