**Academic Diploma with Honors Endorsement Requirements:** 24 credits, plus a seven-semester weighted GPA of 3.8 in grades 9-12, that include six credits in Honors and/or Advanced Placement courses from the BCS core classes of: English, Science, Math, Social Studies, World Languages or Bible.

**Academic Diploma with Fine Arts Endorsement:** 24 credits in grades 9-12 that include 5 credits in fine/performing arts and a seven-semester weighted GPA of 3.0 or higher.

**Academic Diploma with Fine Arts and Honors Endorsement Requirements:** 24 credits in grades 9-12 that include six credits in Honors and/or Advanced Placement courses, five credits in fine/performing arts and a seven-semester weighted GPA of 3.8 or higher. Students must declare intent to pursue this option when entering the 9th grade.
