7. BOARD ACTION ITEMS

A. Second Reading of Policies

Recommended Motion: That this is the second reading of Policy 5136- that students may use personal communication devices (PCDs) before and after school, and/or at school related functions. Use of PCDs, except those approved by a teacher or administrator, at any other time is prohibited and they must be powered completely off (i.e., not just placed into vibrate or silent mode) and stored out of sight.

B. Surplus Property

Recommended Motion: To accept the bids for the following surplus property from Danny Troop for 2007 school bus at \$1,202.75, 2011 school bus at \$1,204.75, and Ford Ranger truck at \$175.25. In the event that Mr. Troop declines final Board bid, then said property is to be sold in order to the following bidders: Mark Vollick for the 2011 bus at \$1,501(2nd bid), Joel Schultz for the Ford Ranger truck at \$105 (2nd bid), and Beck Stoyhoff for the Ford Ranger truck (3rd bid).

C. Hire 1st Grade Teacher

Recommended Motion: To approve to hire Mary Browning at first grade teacher per the master agreement, effective 2025-2026 school year.

D. Hire 3rd Grade Teacher

Recommended Motion: To approve to hire an additional teacher for third grade, based on increased enrollment numbers and budget, to split up the current 3rd/4th multi-age classroom into single grade level classrooms.

E. Hire Bus Driver

Recommended Motion: To hire Myrven Dake as bus driver, effective 2025-2026 school year.

F. CD Renewal

Recommended Motion: To approve the CD renewal for CCSS with Tahquamenon Area Credit Union on 9/11/2025.
