Parenting Tip: Catch Your Child Being Good

Notice and praise your child when they are doing something positive. Be specific, like saying "I really like how you shared your toy with your sister." This makes your child feel proud and builds their confidence. Over time, they'll be more likely to repeat that good behavior. Attention to positive behavior is the biggest deterrent of negative behavior.
