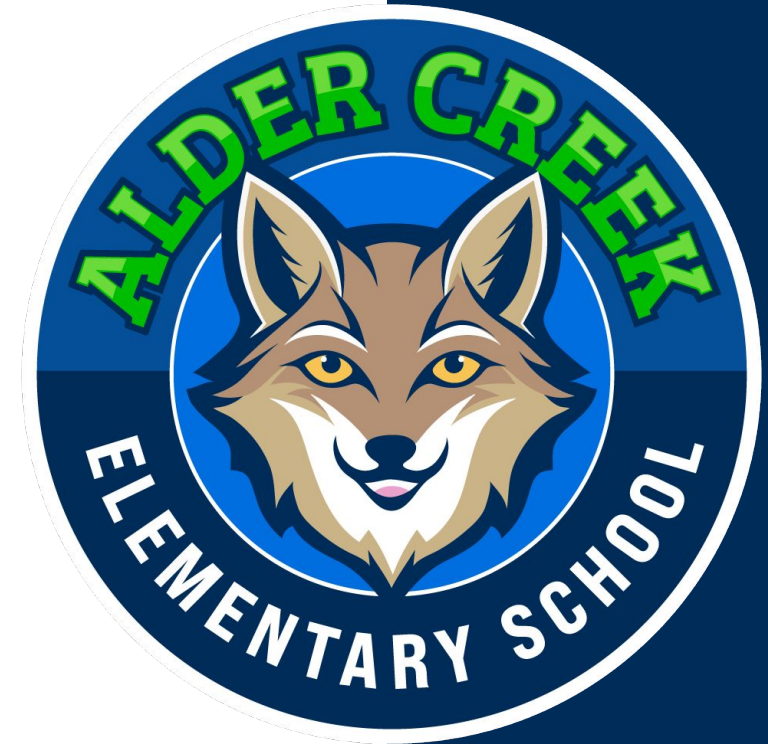

## **Plants Have Stems**

If the plant gets lots of buds, the stem can slump. If the stem slumps, the plant can not stand up. But you can help! You can get a splint to fix the slump. Strap the splint to the stem and see it help the plant stand up.
