With the CHS stadium complex project progressing, the CSD Athletic Department has made changes to the schedules for football and other fall sports. Our priority remains providing a meaningful and spirited experience for our student-athletes and fans while stadium complex construction is underway.

We have explored various options and prioritized all stadium construction requests by the contractors, but have, unfortunately, been unable to find a path that allows for the Stadium Complex project to be completed before the end of the fall sports season. We know how meaningful events like Homecoming and Senior Night are for our students, families, and community, and we deeply share in the disappointment of having to relocate games. We sincerely apologize for the inconvenience and truly appreciate your patience and understanding as we work to deliver a facility that will serve our community for many years to come.

Football Games

The Panthers will play their **Homecoming game on Friday, September 19 at 7 p.m. versus Bensalem at Wissahickon High School (521 Houston Rd., Ambler, PA 19002)**. The **October 10 home game versus Upper Dublin has been moved to the Cardinals' home field (800 Loch Alsh Ave., Fort Washington, PA 19034)**. Kickoff is at **7 p.m.** Since this game will make two consecutive years of the Panthers playing at Upper Dublin, the Cardinals will play at Cheltenham in 2026 and 2027. The **Panthers' Senior Night game on October 17 versus Truman will be played at Springfield Township High School (1801 Paper Mill Rd., Erdenheim, PA 19038) at 7 p.m.** Student fan buses will be available for these three games.
