2024-25 accomplishments we are proud to celebrate, because of the impact on learning and teaching for each and every learner.

- We offer 32 AP classes. One third of all CHS students took at least one Advanced Placement (AP) exam. 506 CHS students took a total of 893 AP exams in the 24-25 school year.
- 83% of the students taking an AP test score a 3 or higher on at least one AP test. This can potentially earn college credit
- 100% of AVID (Advancement Via Individual Determination) elective students were accepted to a 4-year institution for the fourth year in a row.
- Offering a comprehensive list of extracurricular offerings in the Arts, Activities, and Athletics - 65% of our Chaska High School students participate annually in a fee-based school program offering.
- 2 National Merit Scholars Semifinalist for the 25-26 school year.
- 92% of students responding to our spring end of year survey agreed or strongly agreed with the statement "I am seen, heard, valued, and respected for who I am and who I want to be."
- 90% of families responding to our spring end of year survey agreed or strongly agreed with the statement " My child's education helps them grow as a person, not just academically, and prepares them for whatever path they choose after high school."
- \$145,000 in community-supported scholarships were presented to our Class of 2025 graduates.
