Compared to the State of Florida and global schools, OCS students outperformed each in AP scores. Below are a few examples:



In 2024-2025, OCS students set an all-time high on AP exams. **7 of our 11 AP courses had a 100% pass rate.** 94 HS students, grades 10-12, took 165 exams with 91% of students earning a passing score of 3 or higher, equating to 661 college hours, or nearly \$903,367 in saved private school tuition or \$140,601 in public school tuition.
