



## **Notice of Nondiscrimination**

### **Parking on Campus**

There is an annual \$50 district parking permit fee. The fee is \$25 for Washington Square and \$25 at your student's home high school and Washington Square if students will be parking at both campuses.

To obtain a parking permit for Washington Square, students must do the following:

- Bring their car registration to Campus Security or the main office at Washington Square.
- Complete the Washington Square parking permit application.
- Pay the \$25 fee at Washington Square, on PayForIt, or at their home high school.

### **Pets on School Property**

In an effort to keep our school feeling safe for all students and families and in accordance with District Policy, only service animals and therapy dogs are permitted on school property. District Policy requires prior authorization from the principal to have a therapy dog on school property. We ask that all other pets remain off school grounds during school hours. We appreciate your cooperation with this request.

### **Visitor/Parent Check-In**

Parents and visitors are welcome in Adams 12 Schools. Student and staff safety will be prioritized in our school. All visitors during regular business hours must check in at the main entrance/secured vestibule. Visitors may not access other doors to enter our school. A valid ID must be presented at the time you arrive at school and will be used in the Raptor visitor tracking system. Classroom visits by parents or guardians should be approved 24 hours prior to the visit to avoid disruption of the learning environment. Students who permit friends or siblings to attend school and/or who violate District policy by attending a school where they are not enrolled will be subject to discipline and may be referred to law enforcement. Visitors are required to display a visitor's sticker at all times.
