



WORKMAN HIGH SCHOOL SENIOR CONTRACT 2025 - 2026

Dear Senior Student & Parent/Guardian:

In conjunction with the district's rules and regulations on student behavior and attendance, this contract outlines the expectations for seniors during the remainder of the school year. This does not add any additional requirements but only reinforces behavior policies that are already in place by the school, the district, and Education Code. Any violation of the rules, regulations, and attendance policy could jeopardize the student's involvement in the senior activities listed below. Participation in senior activities is a privilege, not a right, thus is subject to administrative review at any time. Fall semester hours are due December 5, 2025, and the spring semester hours are due on April 17, 2026. No exceptions.

<u>BEHAVIOR POLICY</u>: During the remainder of the school year, no senior student should be found in possession of, under the influence of, or possess a controlled substance. Senior students are not to be involved in senior ditching, pranks, fighting, violence, or vandalism. Senior students shall not be involved in ANY offense that holds grounds for suspension. This policy affects all seniors regardless of graduation status and is subject to the following consequences:

- A. Expulsion from school, activities, and/or police involvement.
- B. Suspension, detention, or transfer to another school or district.
- C. Removal from all graduation activities, potentially including the graduation ceremony.
- D. Restitution for damages.
- E. Police citations and arrest

ATTENDANCE POLICY: Seniors are not to accumulate more than 10 unexcused absences during the school year. 3 tardies = 1 unexcused absence. Accumulating more than 10 unexcused absences will result in the loss of senior activities.

Seniors can make-up unexcused absences by participating in community service and/or detention/study hall. 1 hour of participation = 1 day of unexcused absence. See Mr. Garcia or Ms. Esther in the main office for the form to document your hours. Mr. Garcia must approve and clear all hours for it to count toward clearing up unexcused absence(s).

Violating the BEHAVIOR AND/OR ATTENDANCE POLICIES can result in the loss of the following senior activities:

- 1. Homecoming and Any Other School Dances
- 2. Prom and Prom Court
- 3. Senior Awards Night
- 4. Grad Nite
- 5. Participation in the Graduation Ceremony

You must read, sign, and return this contract to Ms. Liz in the Counseling Department Office. You may make a copy if needed. Lastly, until this form is signed and returned, the student may be denied participation in any of the activities mentioned above. <u>Signing below declares receipt of policy and a clear understanding of what is expected of me as a senior at Workman High School.</u>
