School Bus Safety: Let's All Keep Our Kids Safe

Did you know our Kenton County School District safely transports about 10,000 students every day? Our amazing Transportation Department and bus drivers are committed to getting our kids to and from school safely, and we need your help to make sure our roads are safe for everyone.

Please help keep our students, drivers, and community safe by following these important bus and pedestrian safety rules:

- **Stop for Flashing Red Lights:** When a school bus flashes its red lights and extends its stop arm, it means students are getting on or off. You must stop at least 20 feet away—whether you are approaching from behind or from the opposite direction on an undivided road. Don't ever drive around a stopped bus!
- **Watch for Walkers:** Slow down in and around school zones. Always be on the lookout for students walking and school crossing guards. Remember, it's the law to stop for pedestrians at all street corners and crosswalks—marked or unmarked.
- **Be Patient:** Bus routes are a vital part of our community. Please be patient when you see a bus and plan a little extra time for your commute if you know you'll be in a school zone.

Telecommunication Devices/ Messages Policy

In compliance with Kentucky Law, and as referenced in the KCSD Code of Conduct (Page 22), KCSD recognizes the growing presence of telecommunication devices in students' lives. To maintain an optimal learning environment the use of all telecommunication devices is strictly prohibited during instructional time.

At Turkey Foot Middle School, all cell phones must be turned off upon entering the school building and remain turned off until the end of the school day (2:40 pm). This includes use throughout the school building, including but not limited to the cafeteria, hallways, and bathrooms. Use of communication devices is not permitted during the school day, any assigned detention, and/or Friday School, etc. Any transmission of images, inappropriate texts, etc. is prohibited and will be disciplined accordingly. Any electronic transmission that occurs after school hours that becomes a disruption to a safe and productive learning environment is subject to school discipline.

Water Bottles

Students are permitted to bring water but will need to bring it in a non-breakable, clear container. We do have a filtered water system so that students may refill their own water bottles. Drinks that are brought as part of a school lunch will need to be consumed during lunch.
