CHECKLIST FOR GRADES 9 & 10

AUGUST

- ◆ August 23rd (Football) & August 25th— Tryouts begin for the 2025 fall sports season for all Varsity and JV sports (9-12th grades). Register on line with Family ID.
- ◆ Check student schedule for correct course selections. Any confusion, email your counselor—name is on the top of the schedule.

SEPTEMBER

- ◆ September 4th - Attend High School Open House at 6:00 p.m.
- ◆ 1st semester First Year Seminar begins.
- ◆ September 8th - Attend Financial Aid College Workshop 6:00 p.m. in the Performing Arts Center. Parents and students welcome.

OCTOBER

- ◆ October 1st— Last day to add a class.
- ◆ Encourage sign-up for extra-curricular activities/clubs.
- ◆ October 10th - Review first quarter progress report. Any questions or concerns, call teachers/counselor.
- ◆ October 15th - **9th & 10th Grade Parents Attend** “Conversations with the Counselors at 7:00 p.m.

NOVEMBER

- ◆ November 7th - Last day to drop a class.
- ◆ November 14th—SWBOCES Career Fair— all Sophomores will attend.

NOVEMBER (cont.)

- ◆ November 14th - Check first quarter report card. Any concerns, call teachers/ counselor.
- ◆ Sign up for winter sports.

DECEMBER

- ◆ December 9th - Review second quarter progress report. Any questions or concerns, call teachers/counselor.

JANUARY

- ◆ Students should attend review sessions for midterm exams offered by teachers.
- ◆ January 20th-23rd - Mid-term exams.
- ◆ Apply for college summer programs.

FEBRUARY

- ◆ 2nd semester First Year Seminar begins.
- ◆ February 6th- Review second quarter report card. Any questions or concerns, call teachers/counselor.
- ◆ Course selection begins. Parents are encouraged to call the School Counseling Office to schedule a course selection meeting with you, your child and their school counselor.
- ◆ Apply for college summer programs.

MARCH

- ◆ March 4th - All sophomores take the Pre-ACT exam during the school day in the morning.
- ◆ March 30th - Review third quarter progress report. Any questions or concerns, call teachers/counselor.

MARCH (cont.)

- ◆ Sign-up for spring sports.

APRIL

- ◆ April 24th - Review third quarter report card. Any questions or concerns, call teachers/counselor.

MAY

- ◆ Mid-May - AP exams.
- ◆ Urge student to begin reviewing for Regents/Finals
- ◆ May 21st - Review final progress report. Any questions or concerns, call teachers/counselor.
- ◆ Sophomores participate in Career Exploration with the Counselors (six week course).

JUNE

- ◆ Students should attend review sessions offered by teachers.
- ◆ June 9, 10, 17, 18, 22, 23, 24, and 25 - Regents/Final exams.
- ◆ Sign up for summer school or August Regents, if needed.
- ◆ Review final report card and check for accuracy.
- ◆ Apply for summer jobs or internships.

JULY

- ◆ Begin summer reading.
- ◆ Seek out community service opportunities.
- ◆ Enjoy your summer!
