- ◆ July 11th ACT not offered in NYS
- ◆ Visit college campuses.
- ◆ Research other post high school options.
- ◆ Continue working on college essay(s).
- ◆ Begin summer reading.
- ◆ Try to complete your community service hours.

AUGUST:

- ◆ August 23rd (Football) & August 25th— Tryouts begin for the 2025 fall sports season for all Varsity and JV sports (9-12th grades). Register on line with Family ID.
- ◆ August 29th - **Deadline** to register for the September 13th SAT.
- ◆ Check student schedule for correct course selections. Any confusion, email your School Counselor.

SEPTEMBER

- ◆ September 4th - Attend High School Open House at 6:00 p.m.
- ◆ September 8th—Attend Financial Aid College Workshop 6:00 pm in the MS/HS Performing Arts Center. Parents/guardians and students welcome.
- ◆ September 13th –SAT.
- ◆ Remind student this year is critical for college admissions.
- ◆ September 17—SUNY New Paltz bus tour.
- ◆ September 19th - **Deadline** to register for the October 4th SAT.

OCTOBER

- ◆ October 1st—Last day to add a class.
- ◆ Sign-up for extra-curricular activities.

APRIL

- ◆ April 11th - ACT

MAY

- ◆ May 2nd SAT
- ◆ May 8th – **Deadline** to register for June 13th ACT.

- ◆ May 21st - Review final progress report. Any questions or concerns, call teachers/counselor.
- ◆ May 22nd - **Deadline** to register for June 6th SAT.
